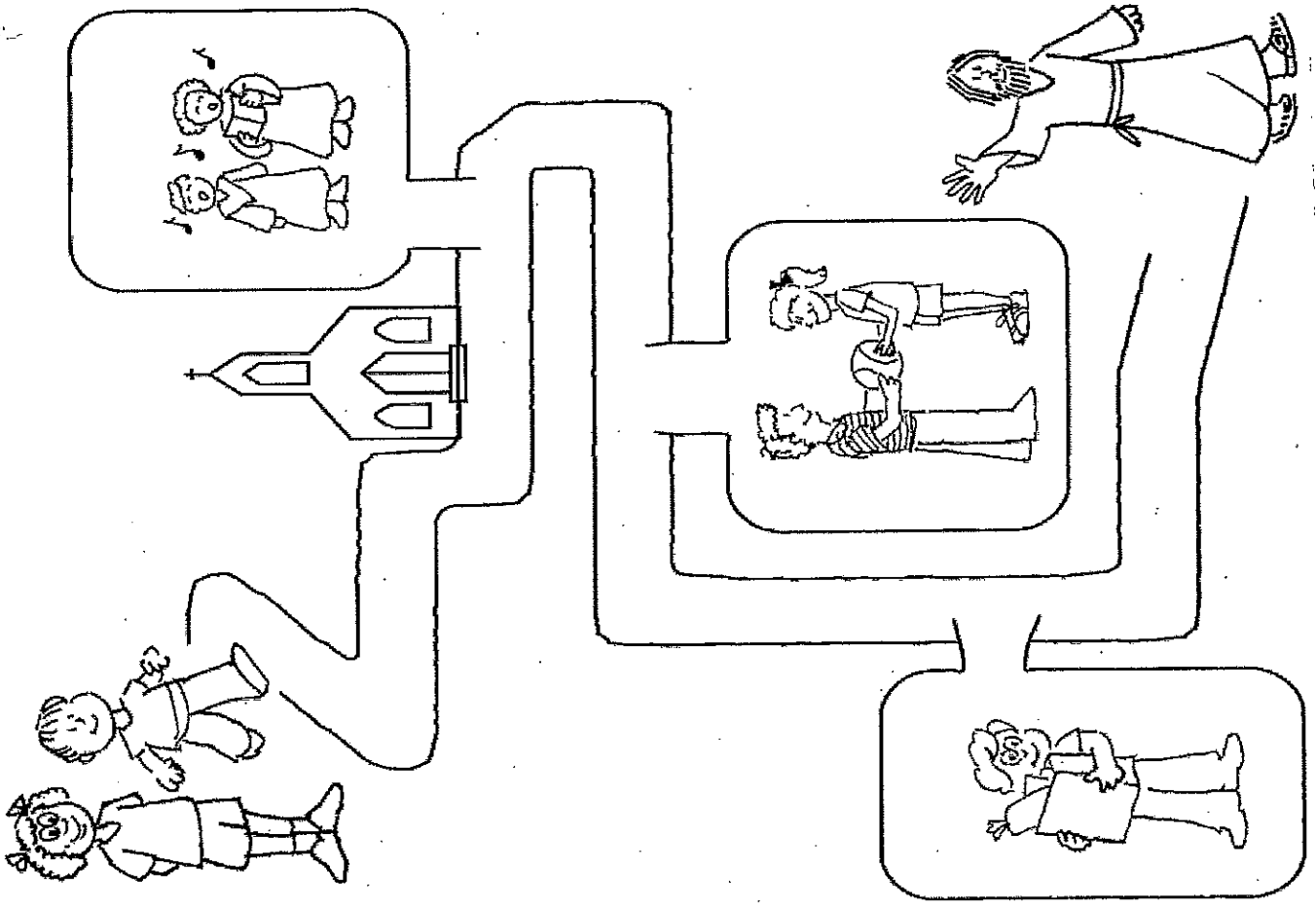

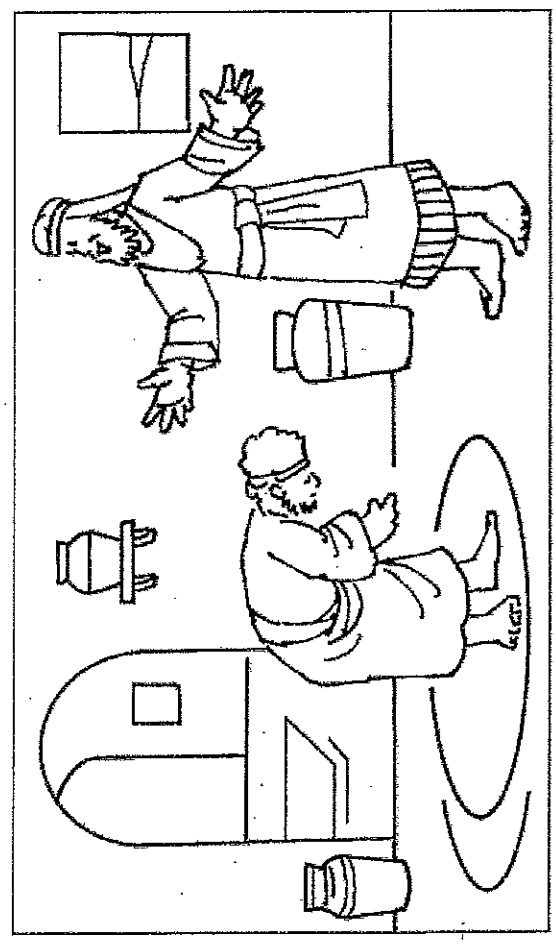
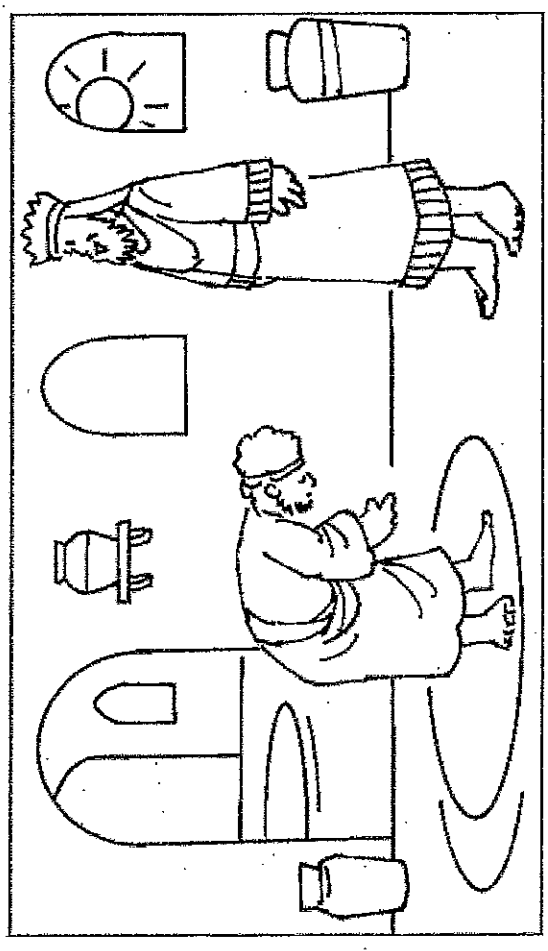

Circle 7 differences in the 2nd picture.

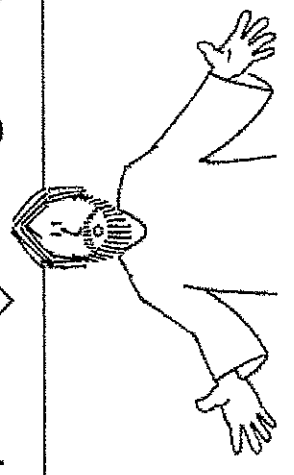
