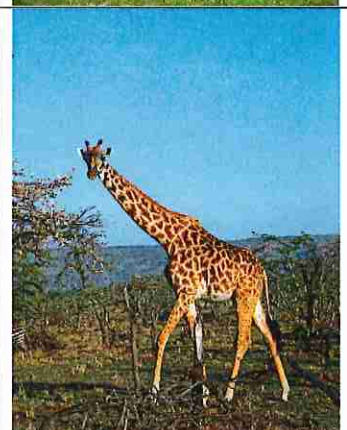
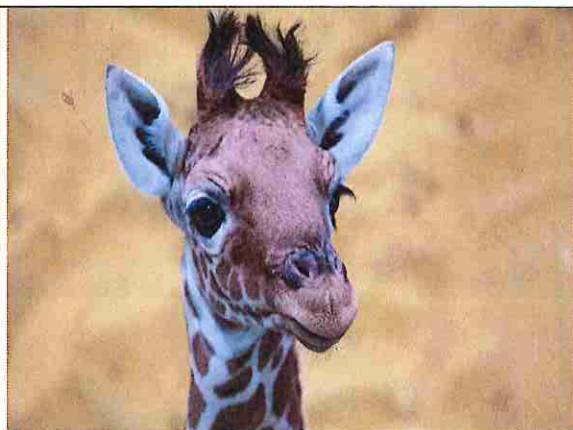

**Dear Girls and Boys,**

Do you like pictures of newborn animals?  
The top two pictures are two different baby animals only a few hours old.  
The bottom pictures are the same animals that are several months old.  
Baby pandas and baby kangaroos are about the size of a peanut when they are born.



You probably already know that tadpoles grow into frogs. Caterpillars grow into butterflies. Most animals look just like their parents when they are born. They grow bigger and bigger as they get older. A baby giraffe is 6 feet and a daddy giraffe is 18 feet. The baby looks just like the daddy.



Sometimes little baby boys and girls look just like one of their parents. They grow and walk like their parents; they have eyes and hair like their parents. But sometimes children do not look at all like either one of their parents.

Do you look like your parents or your brothers and sisters?

Do you like to learn new words? This week the Bible has a new word that we will be learning about. The word is SANCTIFY.

Sanctify has a lot to do with looking like your heavenly Father and His Son, Jesus.



**John 17:17-19 Sanctified in the Truth and Sent into the World**

**17 Sanctify them in the truth; Your Word is truth.**

**18** As You sent Me into the world, so I have sent them into the world.

**19** And for their sake I consecrate Myself, that they also may be sanctified in truth.

What does **SANCTIFY** mean?

The Bible teaches us that it means many things but the best meaning for **SANCTIFY** is

To MAKE HOLY!

Who does Jesus want to be sanctified? YOU!

Jesus wants YOU to be holy like He is holy.

How do you get to be holy? Jesus wants your heart to be made holy.

What is Jesus talking about when He says: **Sanctify them in the Truth.**

The Bible is what Jesus uses to make you holy.

Psalms 119 verses 9-11 help us learn about this verse and what it means.

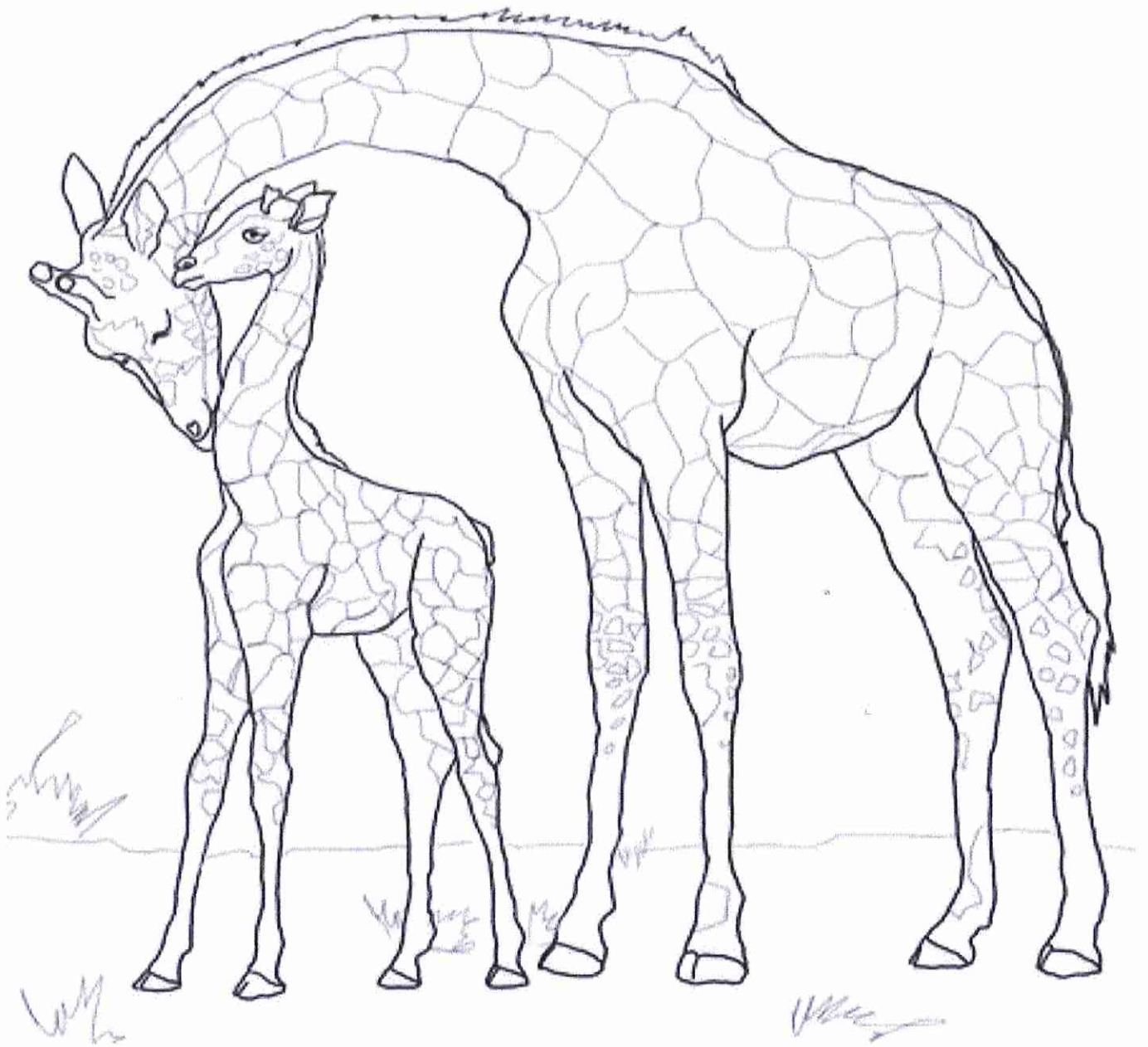
**9** How can a young man keep his way pure? (or young girl) By guarding it according to Your Word.

**10** With my whole heart I seek You; let me not wander from Your commandments!

**11** I have stored up Your Word in my heart, that I might not sin against You.

**Let's put it all together.** Jesus wants you to look like Him. Jesus wants you grow in holiness and be holy as He is holy. We put the Bible in our hearts and God's Word teaches us how to live so we become holy.
