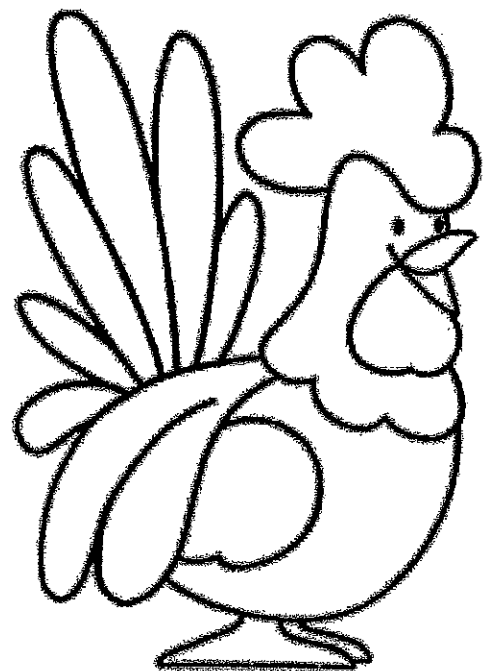
Here are some activity sheets for you this Sunday. You can choose the ones you want.

## Before The Rooster Crows

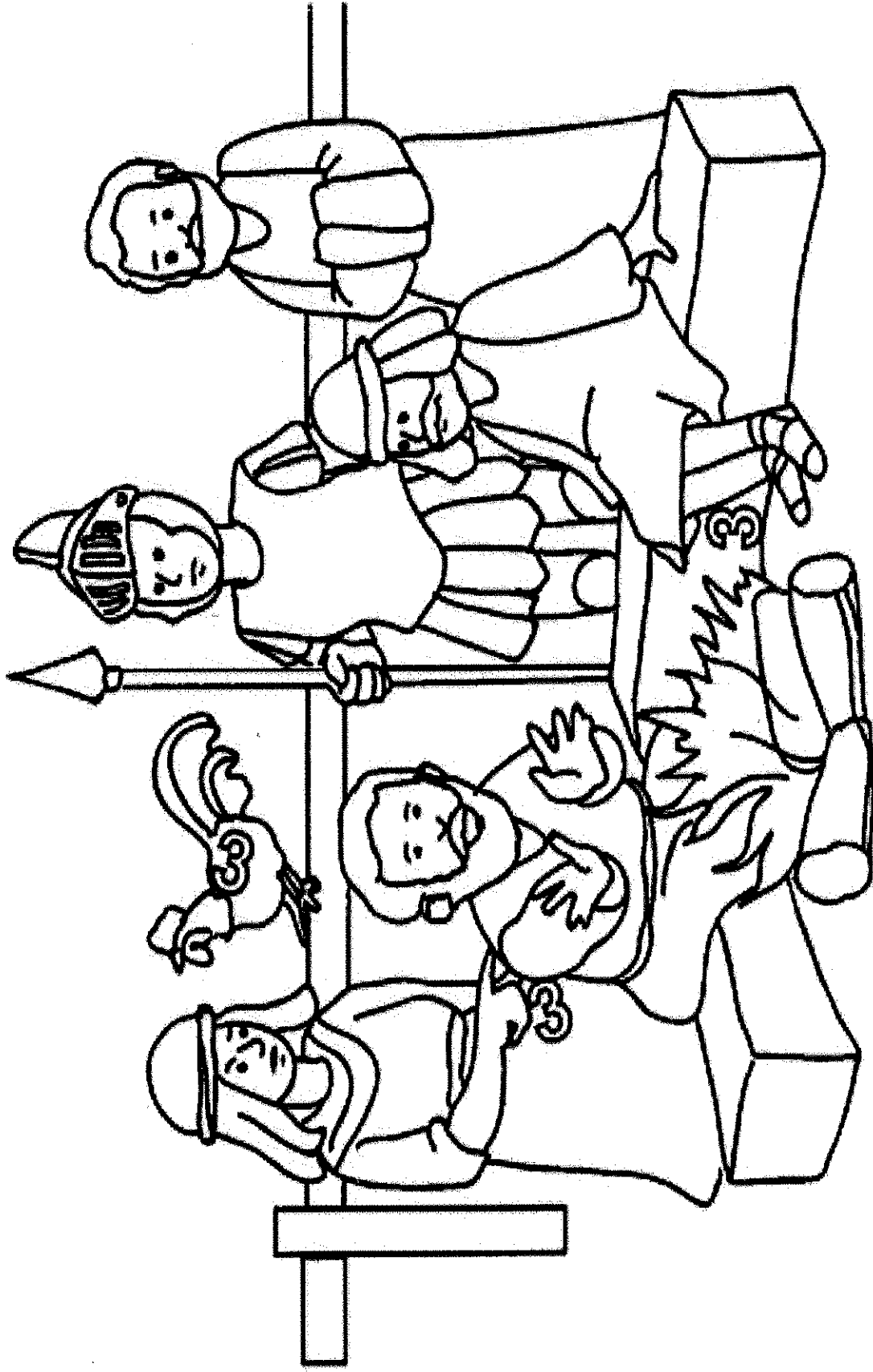
**John 18:12** So the band of soldiers and their captain and the officers of the Jews arrested Jesus and bound Him. **15** Simon Peter followed Jesus, and so did another **disciple** (probably John). Since that disciple was known to the high priest, he entered with Jesus into the courtyard of the high priest, **16** but Peter stood outside at the **door**. So the other disciple went out and spoke to the servant girl who kept watch at the door, and brought Peter in. **17** The servant **girl** at the door said to Peter, "You also are not one of this man's disciples, are you?" He said, "I am not." **18** Now the servants and officers had made a charcoal **fire**. Peter also was with them, standing and warming himself. **19** The high priest then questioned Jesus about His disciples and His teaching. **20** Jesus answered him, "I have spoken **openly** to the **world**. I have always taught in synagogues and in the temple, where all **Jews** come together. I have said nothing in secret. **21** Why do you ask Me? Ask those who have heard Me what I said to them; they know what I said." **22** When He had said these things, one of the officers standing by struck Jesus with his hand, saying, "Is that how You answer the high **priest**?" **23** Jesus answered him, "If what I said is **wrong**, bear witness about the wrong; but if what I said is right, why do you **strike** Me?" **25** Now Simon Peter was standing and warming himself. So they said to him, "You also are not one of His disciples, are you?" He denied it and said, "I am not." **26** One of the servants of the high priest, a relative of the man whose ear Peter had cut off, asked, "Did I not see you in the **garden** with Him?" **27** Peter again denied it, and at once a **rooster** crowed. (with a few edits for space)

What will you do with the love of Jesus that has been poured out for you?



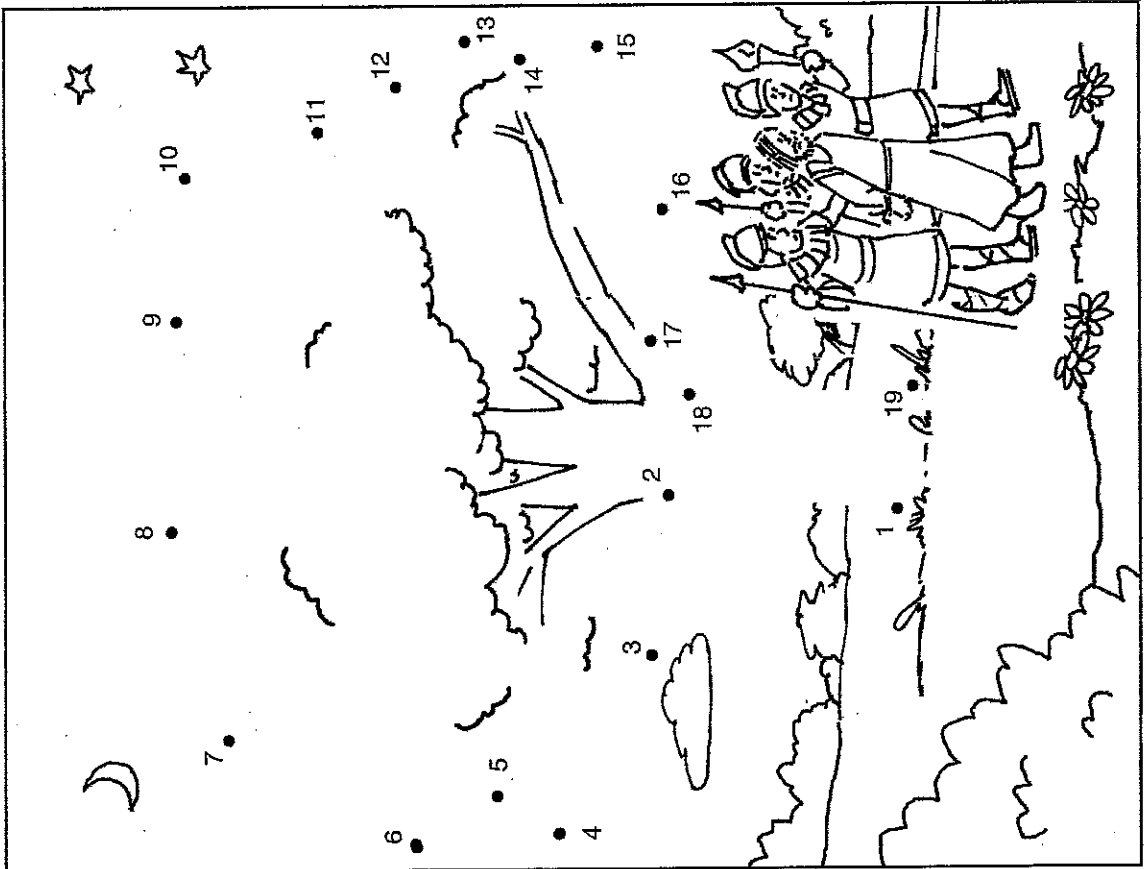

Jesus was arrested and taken away.

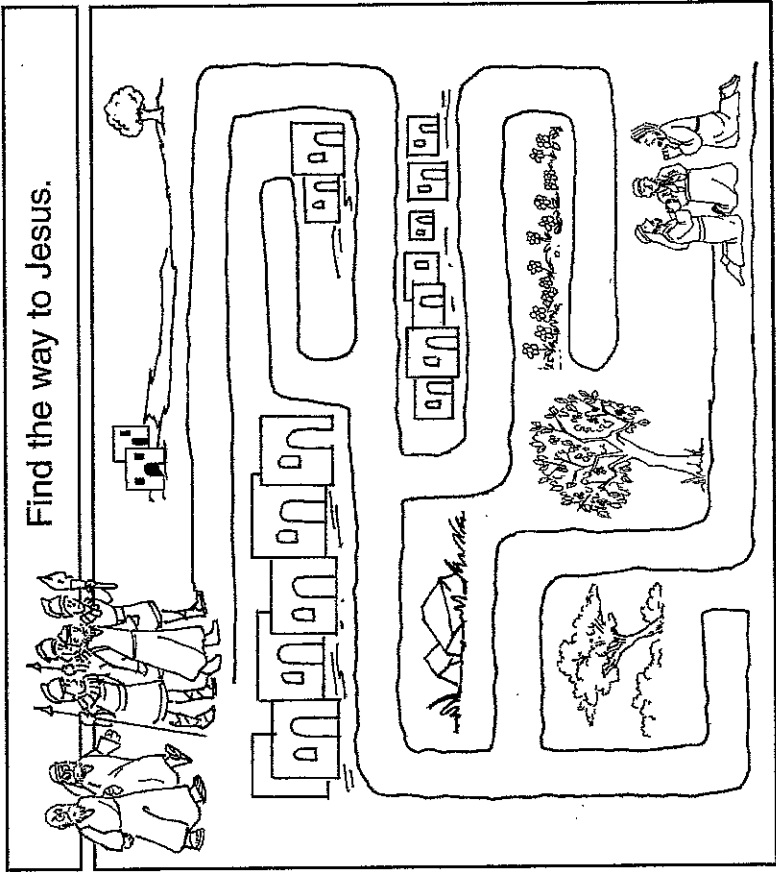

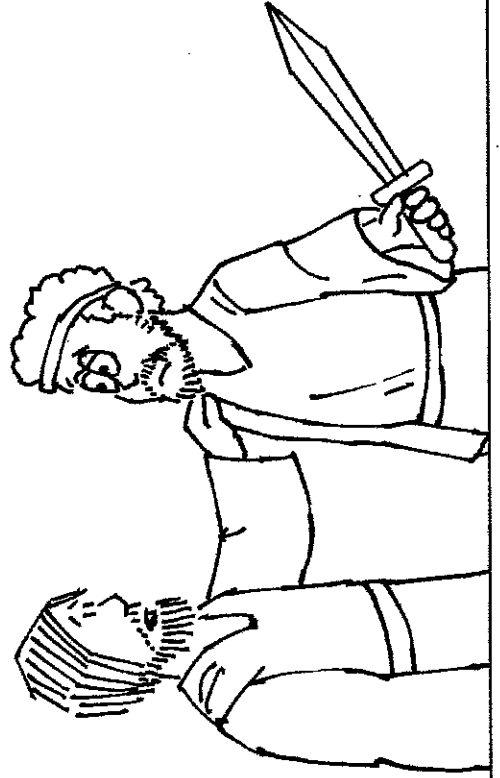

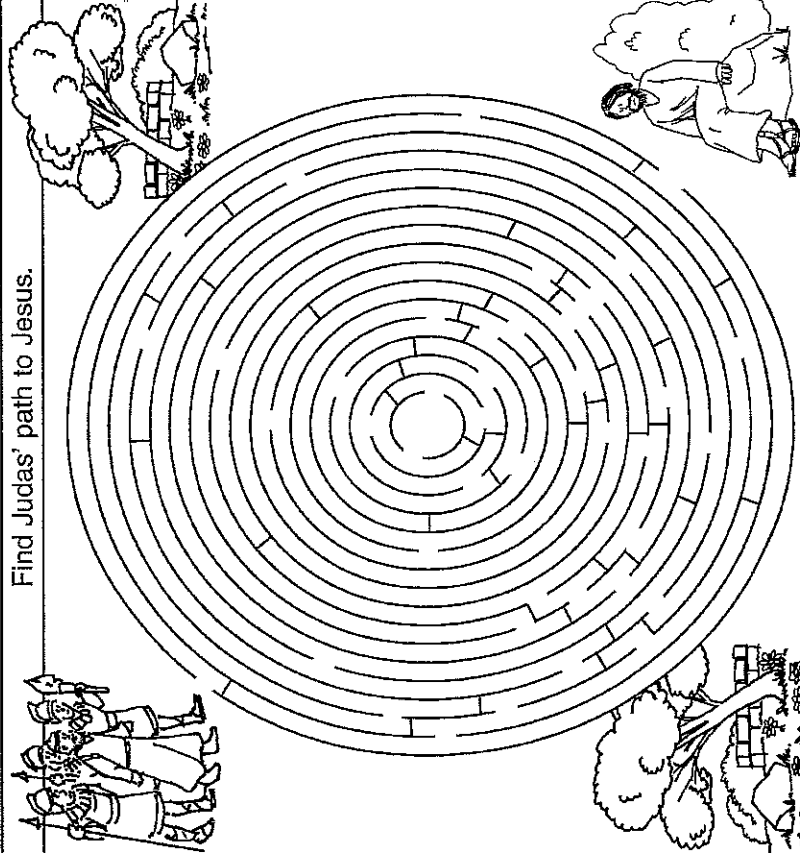


And, after the third time that early morning, the rooster crowed.

Jesus and His disciples went to an olive grove. Judas knew the place and guided soldiers and officials there, carrying torches, lanterns and weapons.

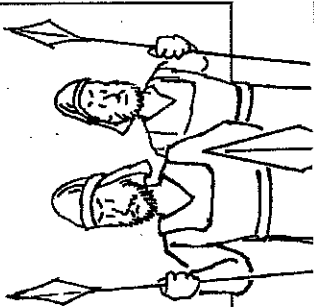
Find Judas' path to Jesus.

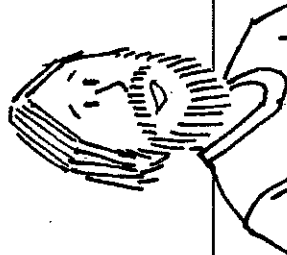
