

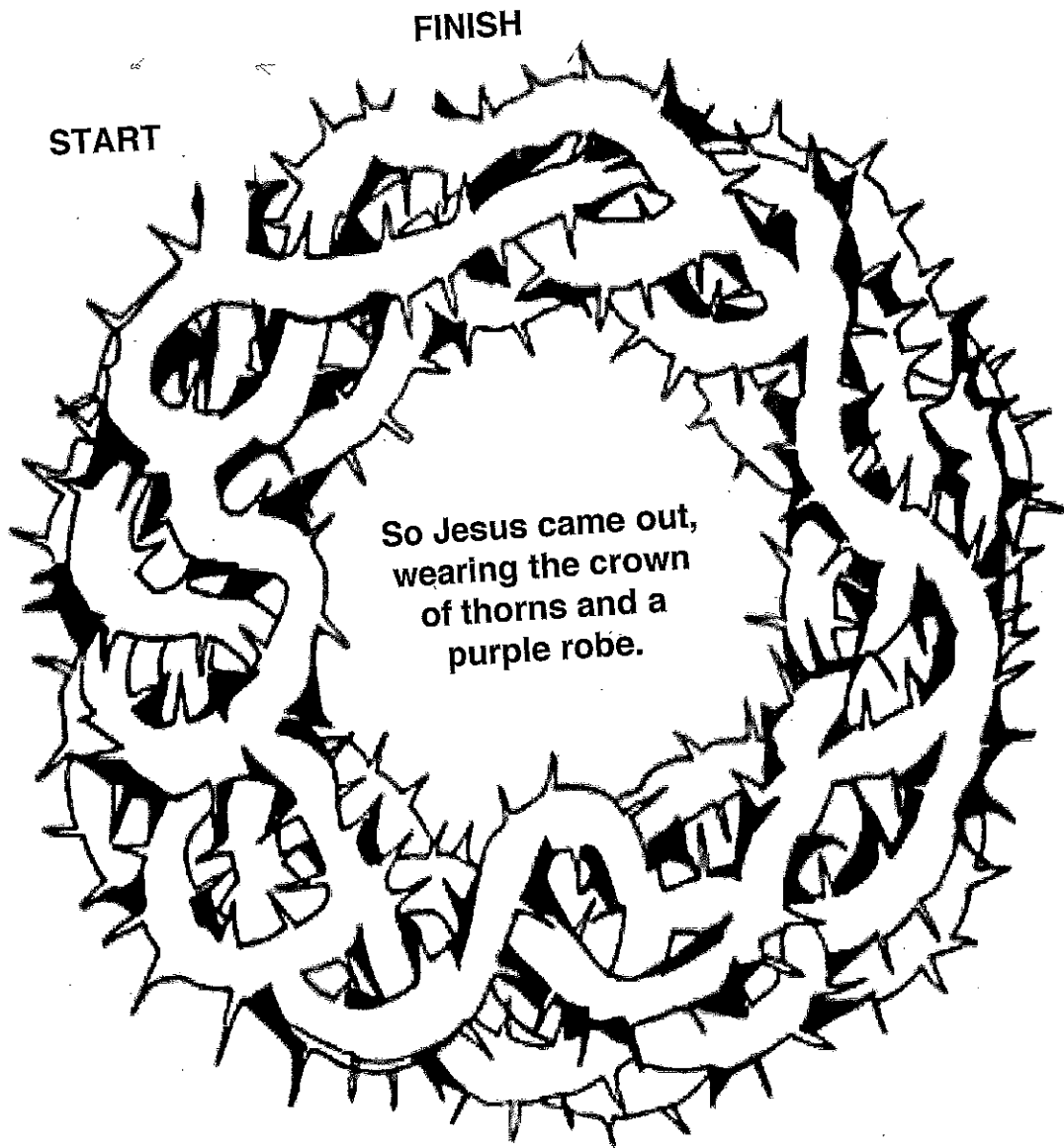
Behold the Man!

| 6 | When the chief priests and the officers saw Him, they cried out, "Crucify Him, crucify Him!" Pilate said to them, "Take Him yourselves and crucify Him, for I find no guilt in Him." | Why didn't Pilate want to get involved? |
| 7 | The Jews answered Him, "We have a law, and according to that law He ought to die because He has made Himself the Son of God." | What law did they say that Jesus broke? |
| 8 | When Pilate heard this statement, he was even more afraid. | Why was Pilate filled with fear? |
| 9 | He entered his headquarters again and said to Jesus, "Where are You from?" But Jesus gave him no answer. | Why was Jesus silent? |
| 10 | So Pilate said to Him, "You will not speak to me? Do You not know that I have authority to release You and authority to crucify You?" | What authority did Pilate think he had? |
| 11 | Jesus answered him, "You would have no authority over Me at all unless it had been given you from above. Therefore he who delivered Me over to you has the greater sin." | What authority did Jesus know that only HE had? |

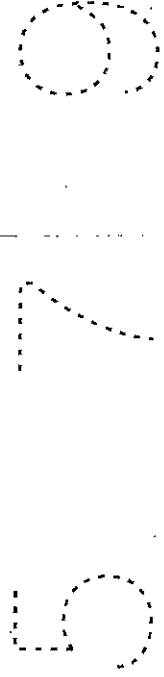
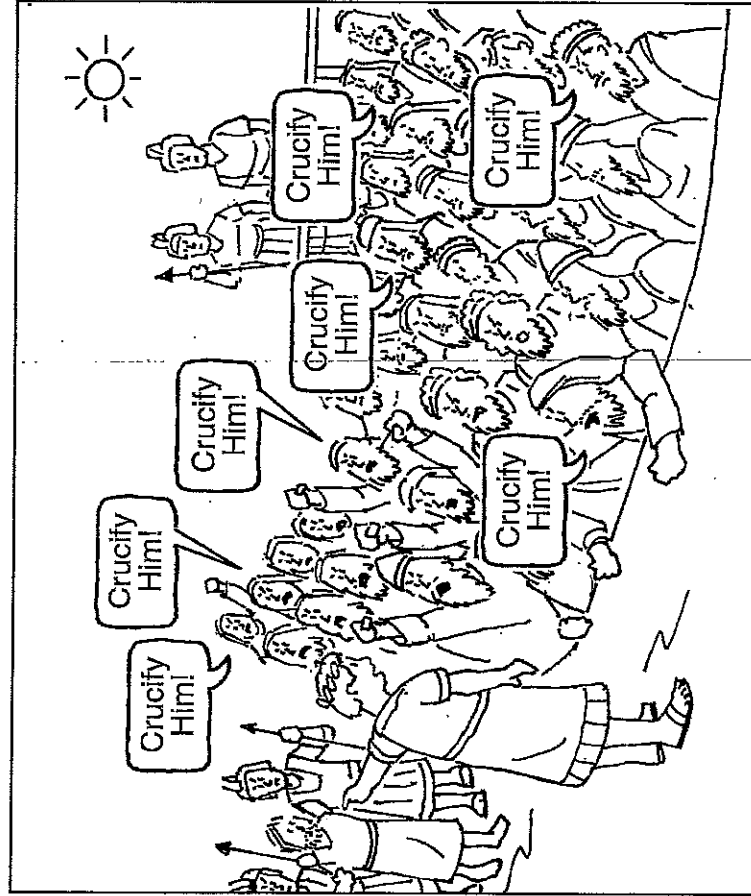
Crown of Thorns Maze

Jesus Before Pilate

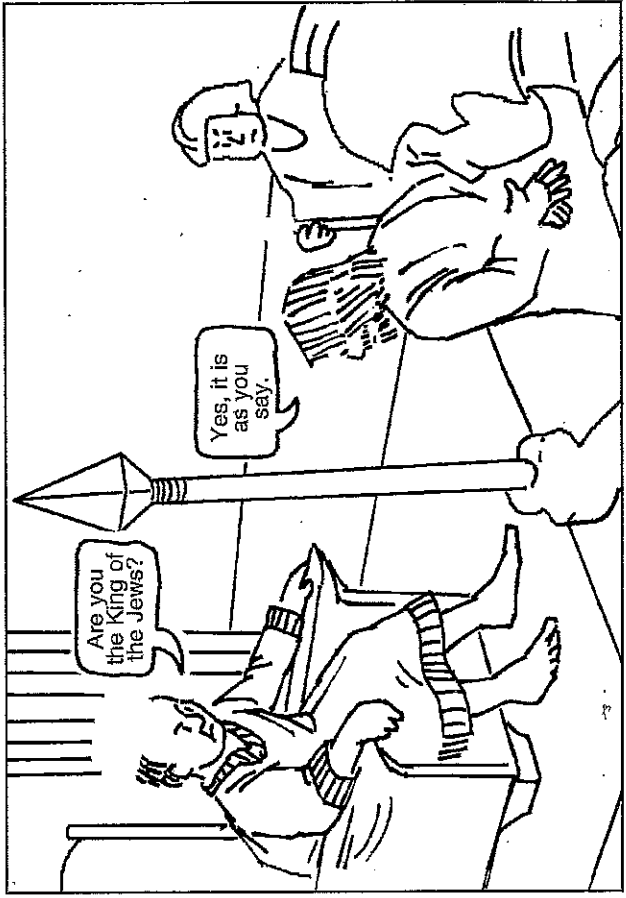
