Luke 1

God Sends John to Prepare Hearts

5 In the <u>time</u> of Herod king of Judea there was a <u>priest</u> named Zechariah; his <u>wife</u> Elizabeth was also a descendant of Aaron. 6Both of them were upright in the sight of God, and they were both well along in years.

8 Once when Zechariah's division was on duty and he was serving as priest before God, 9he was chosen by lot, to go into the temple of the Lord and burn incense. All the assembled worshipers were praying outside.


11Then an angel of the Lord appeared to him, standing at the right side of the altar of incense. 12 When Zechariah saw him, he was startled and was gripped with fear. 13 But the angel <u>said</u> to him: "Do not be afraid, Zechariah; your prayer has been <u>heard</u>. Your wife Elizabeth will bear you a son, and you are to give him the name John. 14 He will be a joy and delight to you, and many will rejoice because of his <u>birth</u>, 15 for he will be great in the <u>sight</u> of the Lord. He will be filled with the Holy Spirit even from birth. 17 And he will go on before the Lord, in the <u>spirit</u> and power of Elijah, to turn the <u>hearts</u> of the fathers to their children and the disobedient to the wisdom of the righteous—to make ready a people prepared for the Lord."

18 Zechariah asked the angel, "How can I be sure of this? I am an old man and my wife is well **along** in years."

19 The angel answered, "I am Gabriel. I stand in the presence of God, and I have been sent to speak to you and to tell you this good news. 20 And now you will be silent and not able to **speak** until the **day** this happens, because you did not believe my words, which will come true at their proper time."




"Praise be to the Lord!"

God promised to send a Savior who would pay for our sins.


And He did – Jesus!

Draw a mouth on Zechariah. Trace his clothes.




A priest named Zechariah and his wife Elizabeth followed the Lord's commandments. They were old and had no children.



An angel named Gabriel appeared to Zechariah. He told him his wife Elizabeth would have a son. His name would be John.






