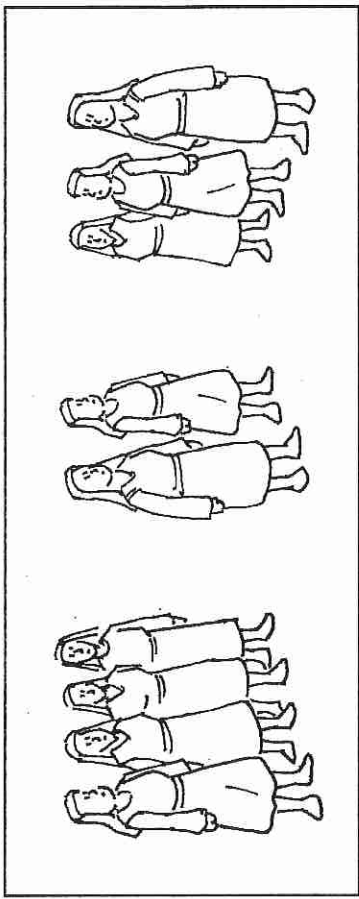

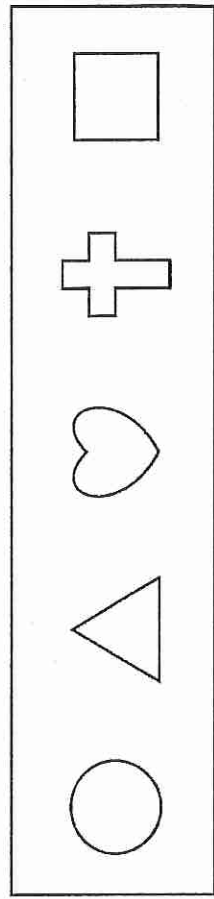
Jesus Speaks From the Cross

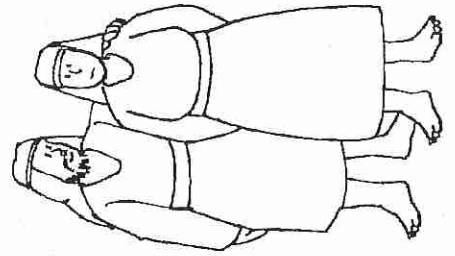

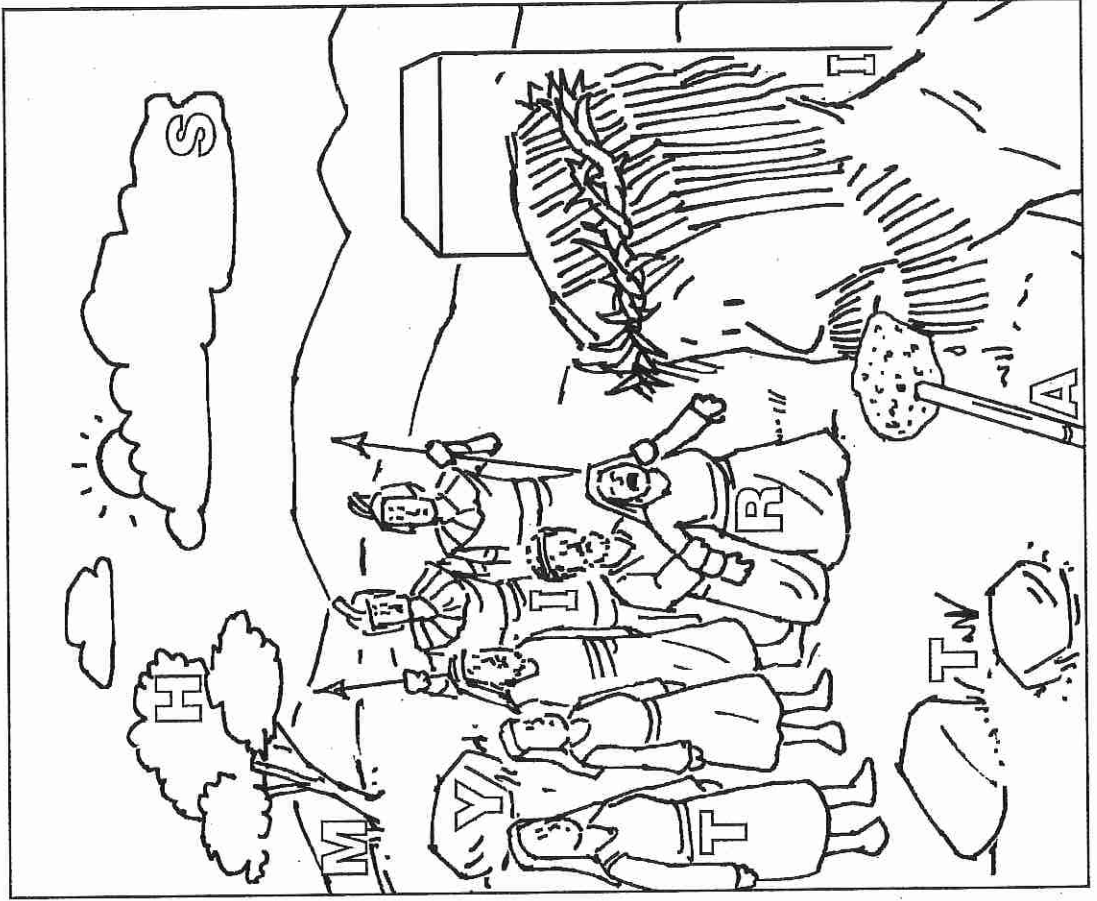

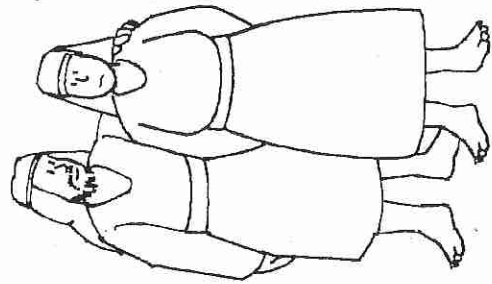
