31	Since it was the day of Preparation, and so that the bodies would not remain on the cross on the Sabbath (for that Sabbath was a high day),	What is the Day of Preparation? What feast is about to happen? Or you could ask: what was being remembered? Why did they want to take Jesus' body off of the cross?
	the Jews asked Pilate that their legs might be broken and that they might be taken away.	Why would the soldiers break the legs of the person being crucified?
32	So the soldiers came and broke the legs of the first, and of the other who had been crucified with Him.	How many men were crucified with Jesus? Why did they break their legs?
33	But when they came to Jesus and saw that He was already dead, they did not break His legs.	Why didn't they break Jesus' legs? How does this show us that Jesus was God's Son and He was a man?
34	But one of the soldiers pierced His side with a spear, and at once there came out blood and water.	What did the soldiers do to Jesus?
35	He who saw it has borne witness—his testimony is true, and he knows that he is telling the truth—that you also may believe.	What is another way to say this sentence?
36	For these things took place that the Scripture might be fulfilled: "Not one of His bones will be broken."	Is it important that the Old Testament tells us about the death of Jesus?
37	And again another Scripture says, "They will look on Him whom they have pierced."	
	How does this passage remind us that Jesus is the Lamb of God?	What else does this passage teach us about Jesus and why He died?



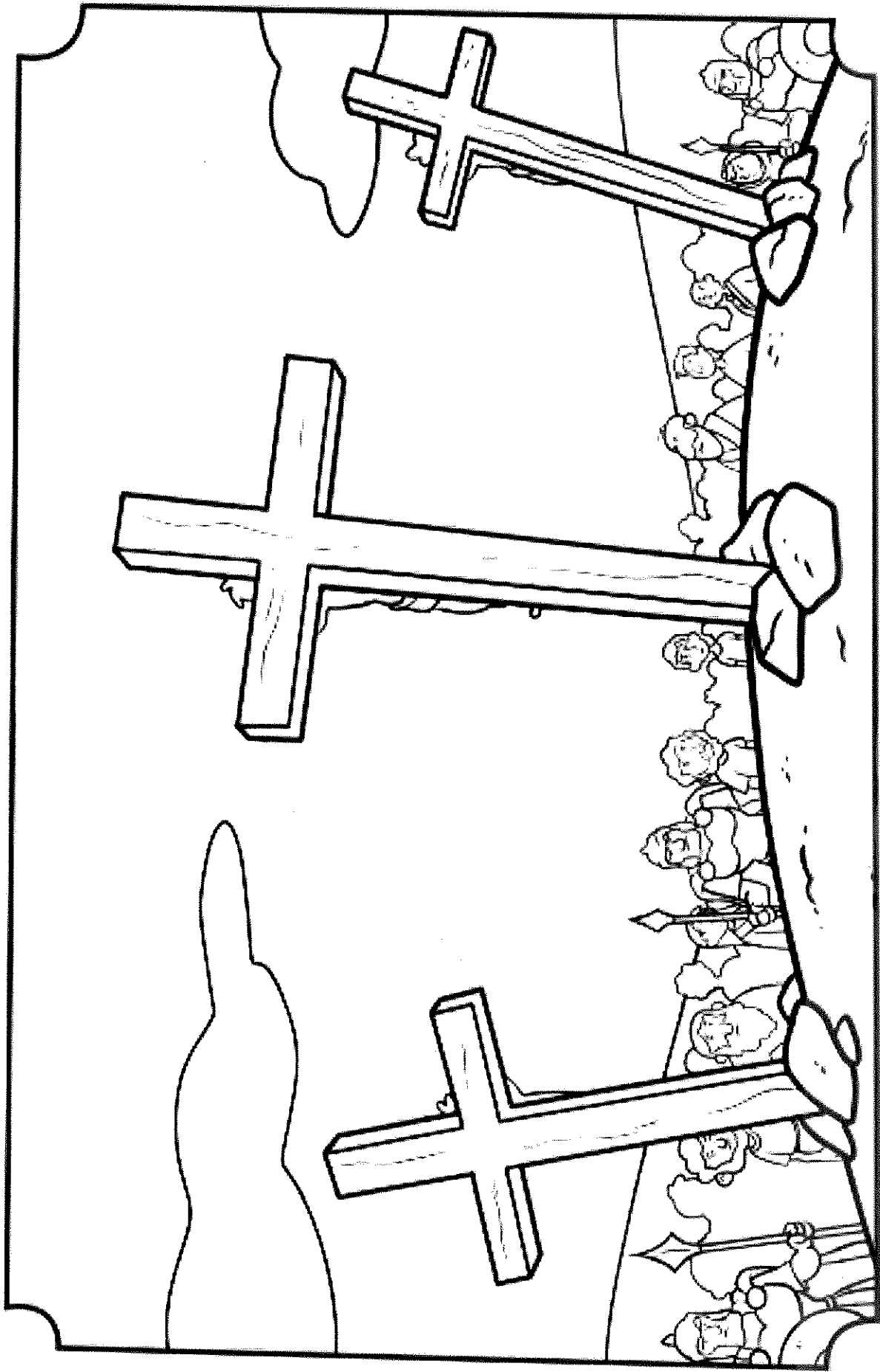
