

**John 19:38-42****Buried in the Garden****2-14-21**

As you listen to the sermon see if you can answer these questions:

38a	After these things Joseph of Arimathea, who was a disciple of Jesus,	What is a disciple?
38b	but secretly for fear of the Jews	Why didn't Joseph want the Jews to know he wanted to get Jesus' body?
38c	asked Pilate that he might take away the body of Jesus, and Pilate gave him permission. So he came and took away His body.	What did Joseph ask Pilate? What did Joseph want to do with Jesus' body?
39	Nicodemus also, who earlier had come to Jesus by night, came bringing a mixture of myrrh and aloes, about seventy-five pounds in weight.	What do you remember about Nicodemus? Why did he bring all the herbs and spices with him?
	<b>For February 14</b>	
40	So they took the body of Jesus and bound it in linen cloths with the spices, as is the burial custom of the Jews.	What did the men do to prepare Jesus' body for burial?
41	Now in the place where He was crucified there was a garden, and in the garden a new tomb in which no one had yet been laid.	What was different about the tomb where Jesus was laid from other tombs?
	<i>What were tombs like in Jesus' day?</i>	
42	So because of the Jewish day of Preparation, since the tomb was close at hand, they laid Jesus there.	
	Why is it so important to know about Jesus' burial? Why is it important that Jesus was buried in a garden? What does it mean that Jesus died for you? And He rose for you too!  What have you learned about gardens in the Bible?

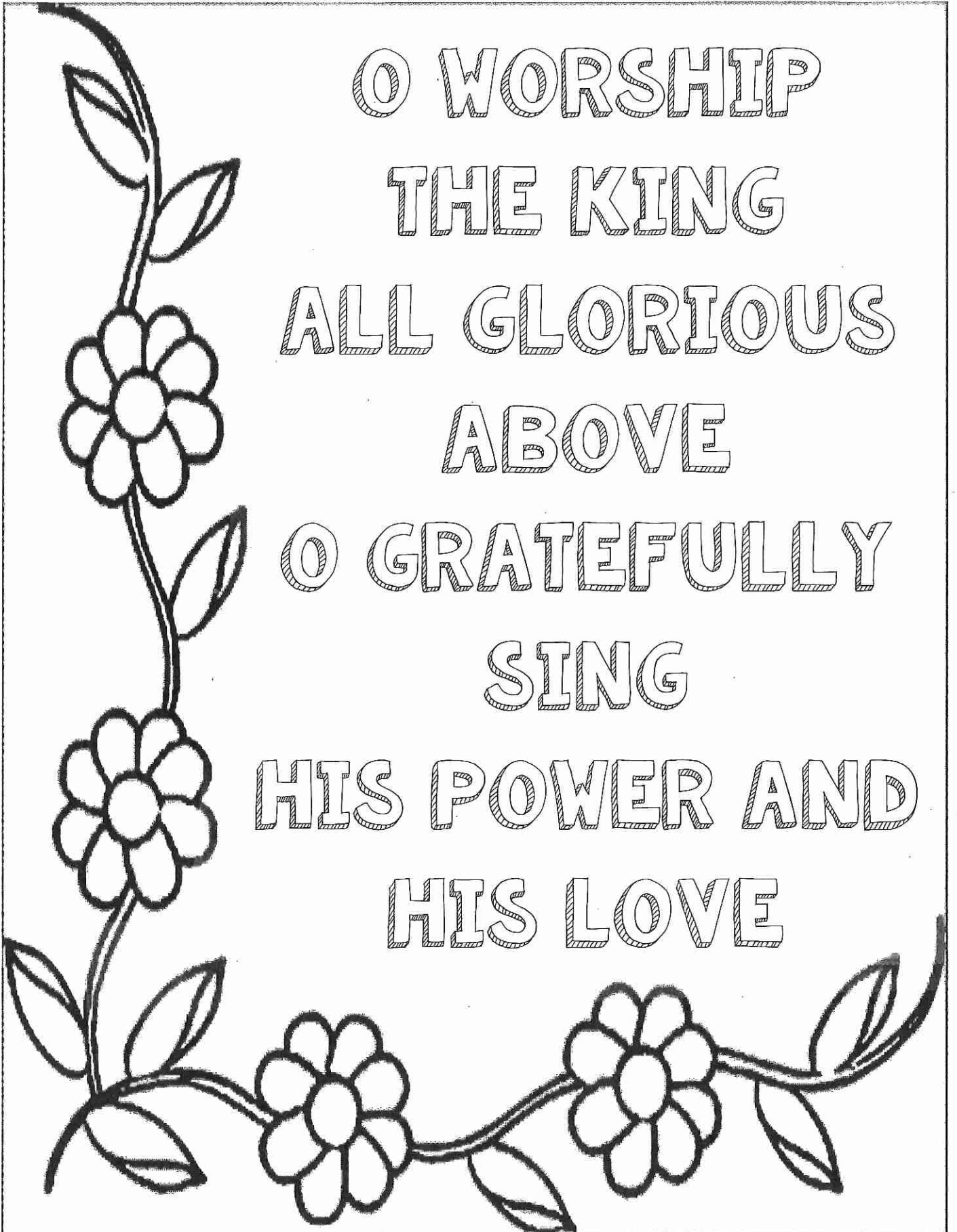

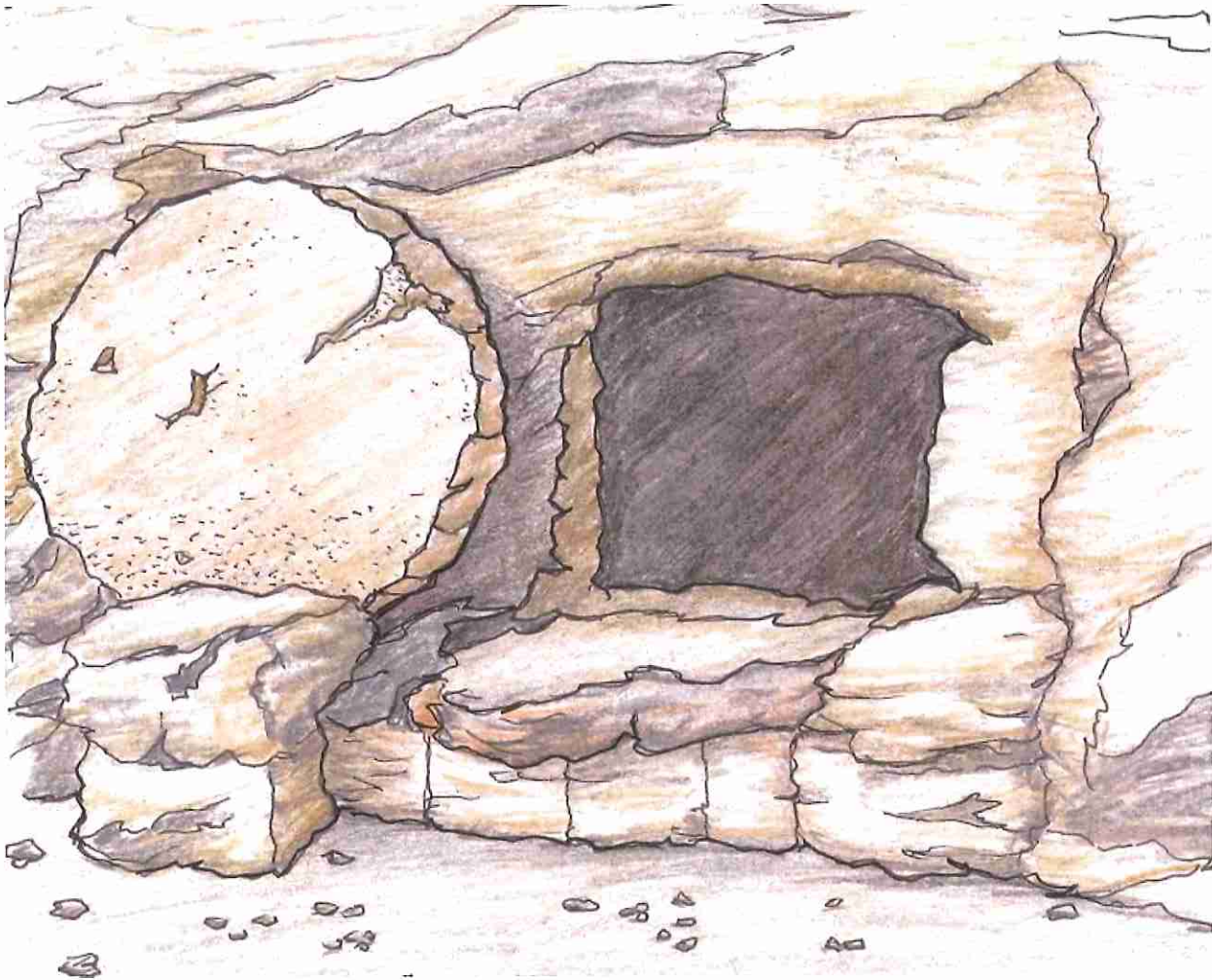
