This is a wonderful portion of scripture on God's love for Mary and for YOU!

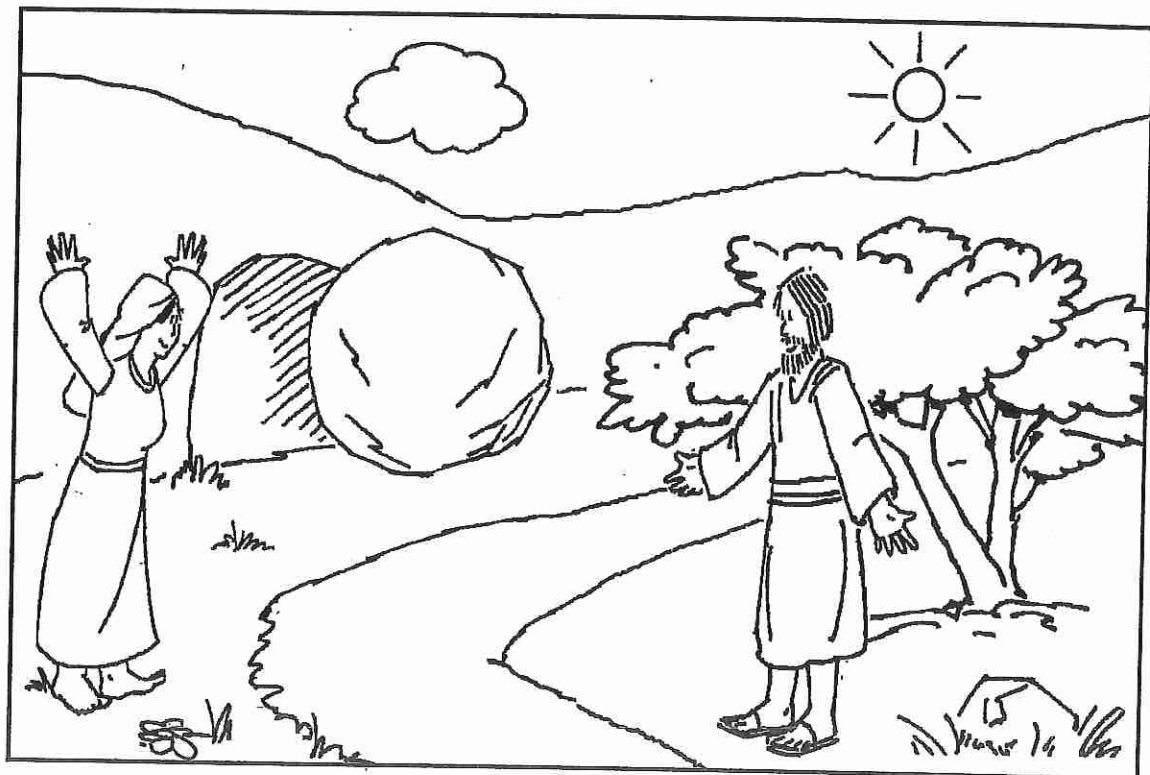
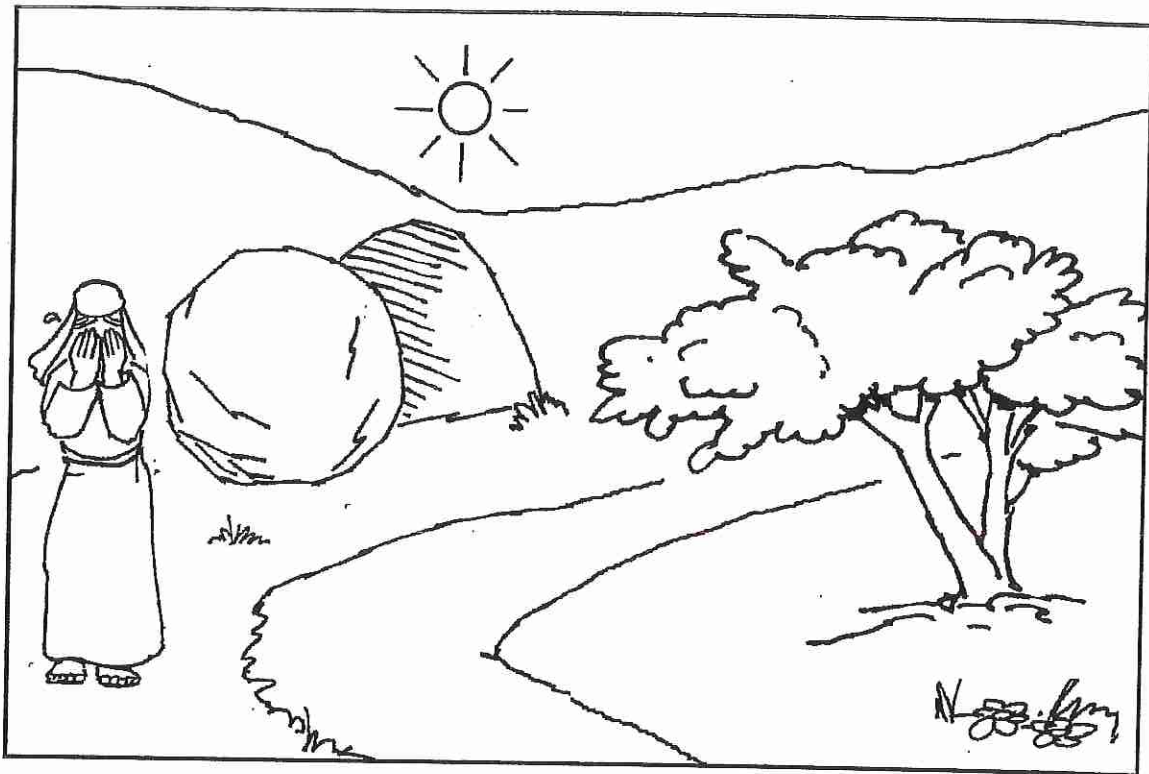
11 12	But Mary stood weeping outside the tomb, and as she wept, she stooped to look into the tomb And she saw two angels in white, sitting where Jesus' body had lain, one at the head and one at the feet.	Why was Mary crying?  What did Mary think she was going to find in the tomb? Who did Mary see in the tomb?
13 14	They said to her, "Woman, why are you weeping?" She said to them, "They have taken away my Lord, and I do not know where they have laid Him."	Did the angels tell her not to weep? What did Mary think had happened to Jesus? Did she remember that Jesus had talked about His resurrection? Why didn't she think He was alive?
	Having said this this, she turned around and saw Jesus standing, but she did not know that it was Jesus.	Why didn't Mary recognize Jesus? Are you surprised that Jesus appeared to Mary first?
15	Jesus said, "Woman, why are you weeping? Whom are you seeking?" Supposing Him to be the gardener, she said to Him, "Sir, if you have carried Him away, tell me where you have laid Him, and I will take Him away."	Who did Mary think was talking with her? What was her plan?
16	Jesus said to her, "Mary." She turned and said to Him in Aramaic, "Rabboni!" (which means Teacher).	What word changed her whole life? How did Jesus know her name?
17	Jesus said, "Do not cling to Me, for I have not yet ascended to the Father; but go to My brothers and say to them, 'I am ascending to My Father and your Father, to My God and your God.' "	What did Jesus tell Mary He was going to do?  What does Jesus call God?
18	Mary Magdalene went and announced to the disciples, "I have seen the Lord!"	What did Mary tell the disciples about Jesus?
	And that He had said these things to her.	

Mary points us to Jesus, to the celebration that Easter is. But Easter is more than a celebration, it is the day that changes your life.

We don't really think about the presents that Jesus gives us on Easter.

1. Coat – white coat of Christ's righteousness; on the cross Jesus took off His coat, to give it to us;
  2. Sticker chart – Jesus gives us His sticker chart;
  3. Treasure chest – what do you want in your treasure chest that will make you so happy?
- You beg (for a toy/something) and you get it. And does it fill your heart with joy and happiness?  
Not for long; Jesus fills your heart. The tomb was empty – so that your heart will be filled with peace—peace with God, forever.

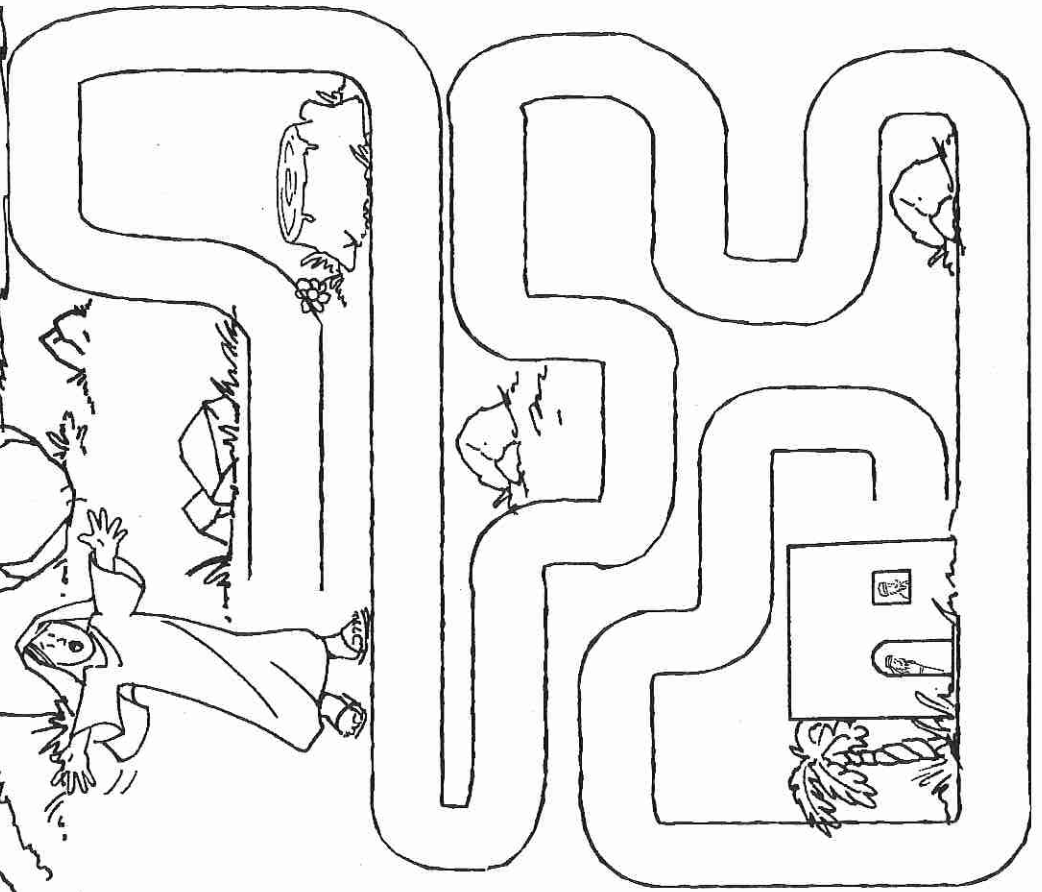
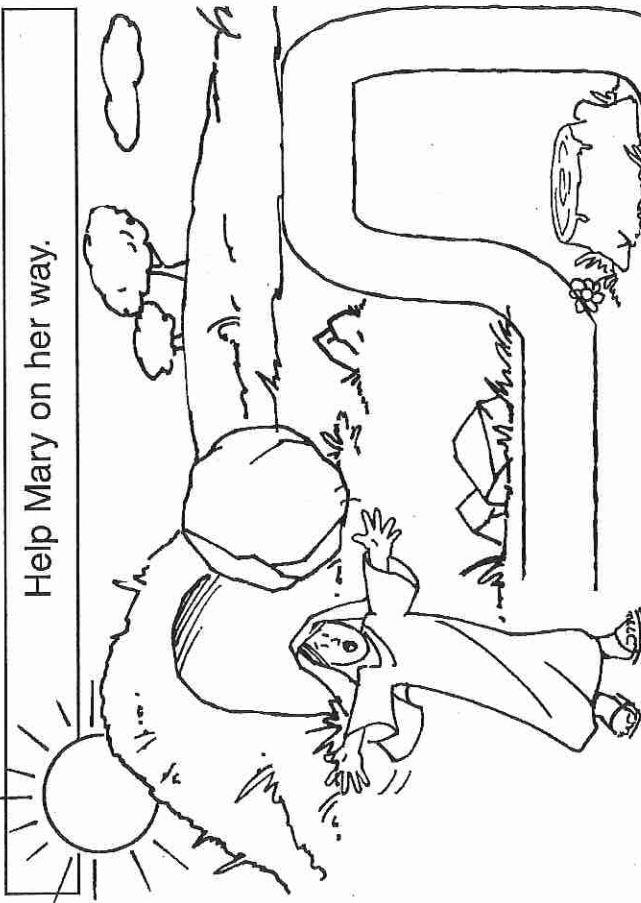

Help Mary on her way.



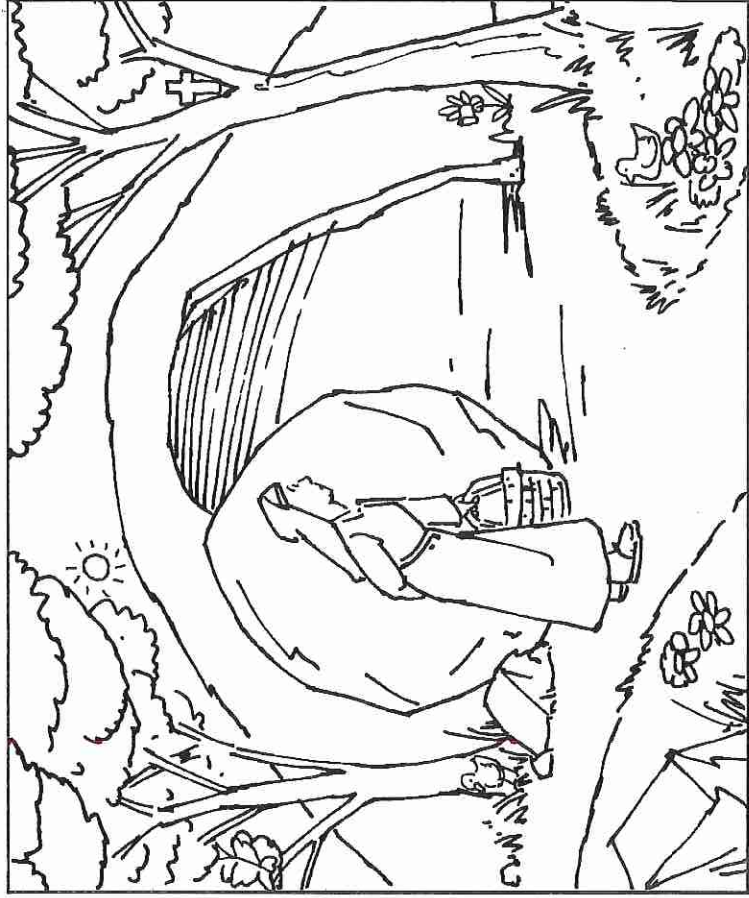

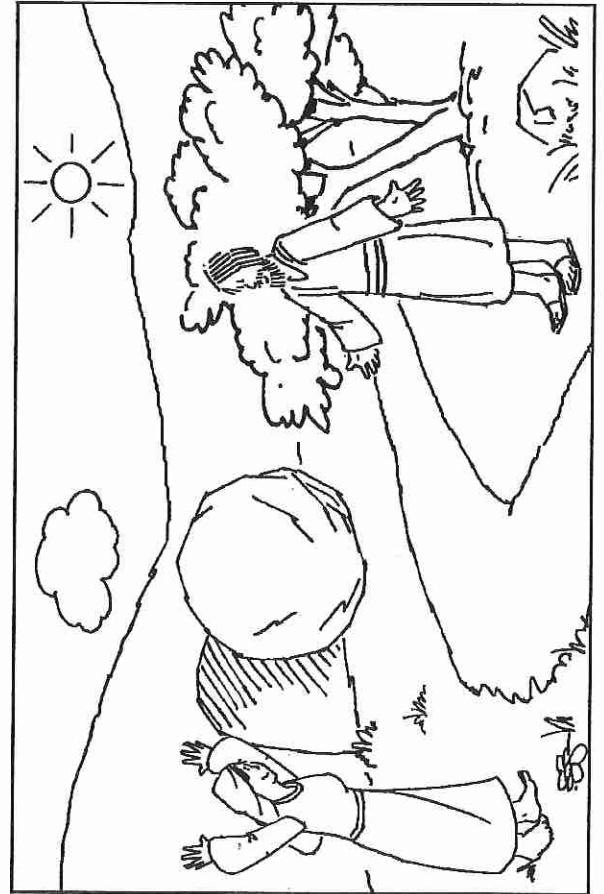
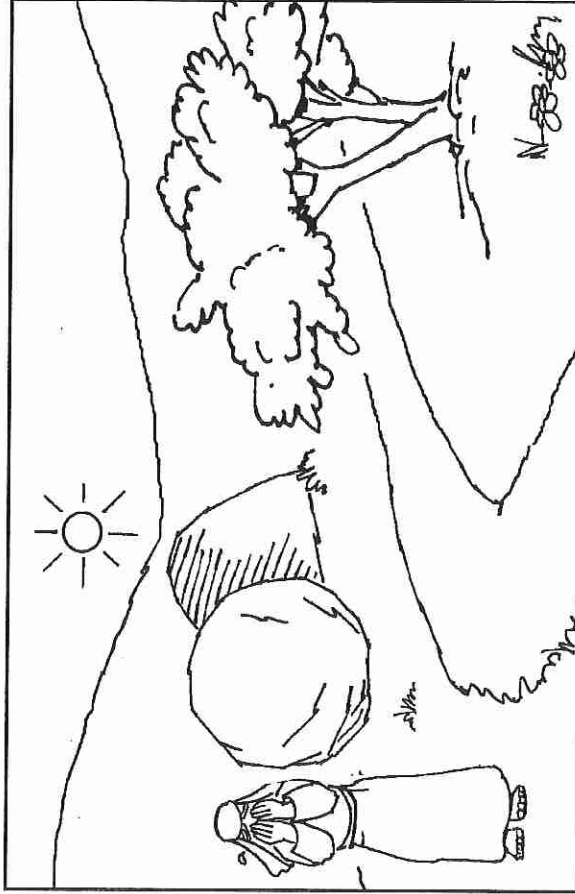
Mary Magdalene went to Jesus' tomb. It was still dark.

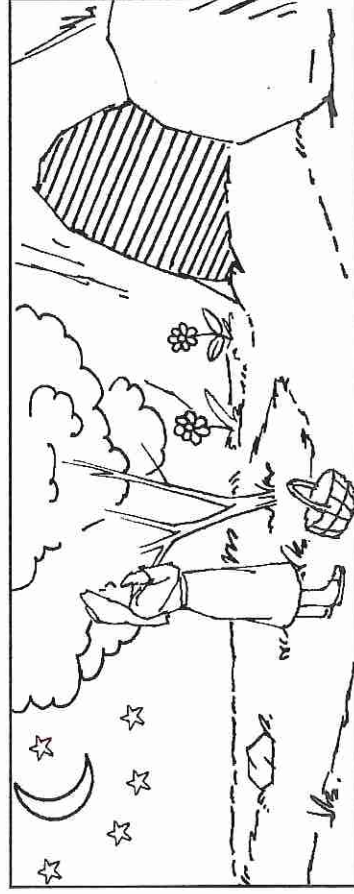
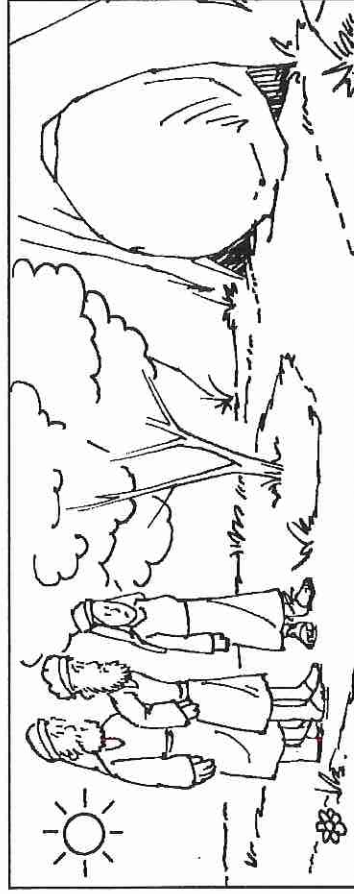

Mary Magdalene went to the tomb of Jesus and saw that the stone had been removed from the entrance. What did she say?

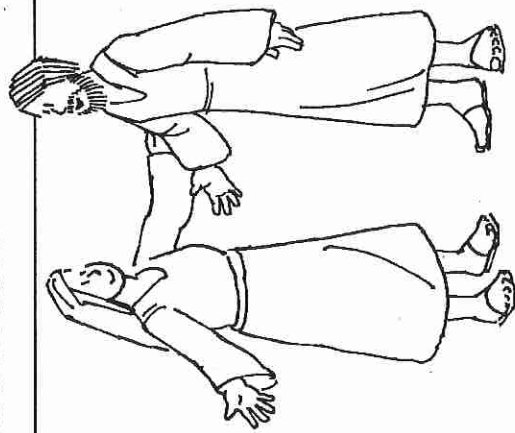

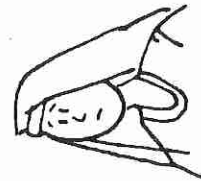
