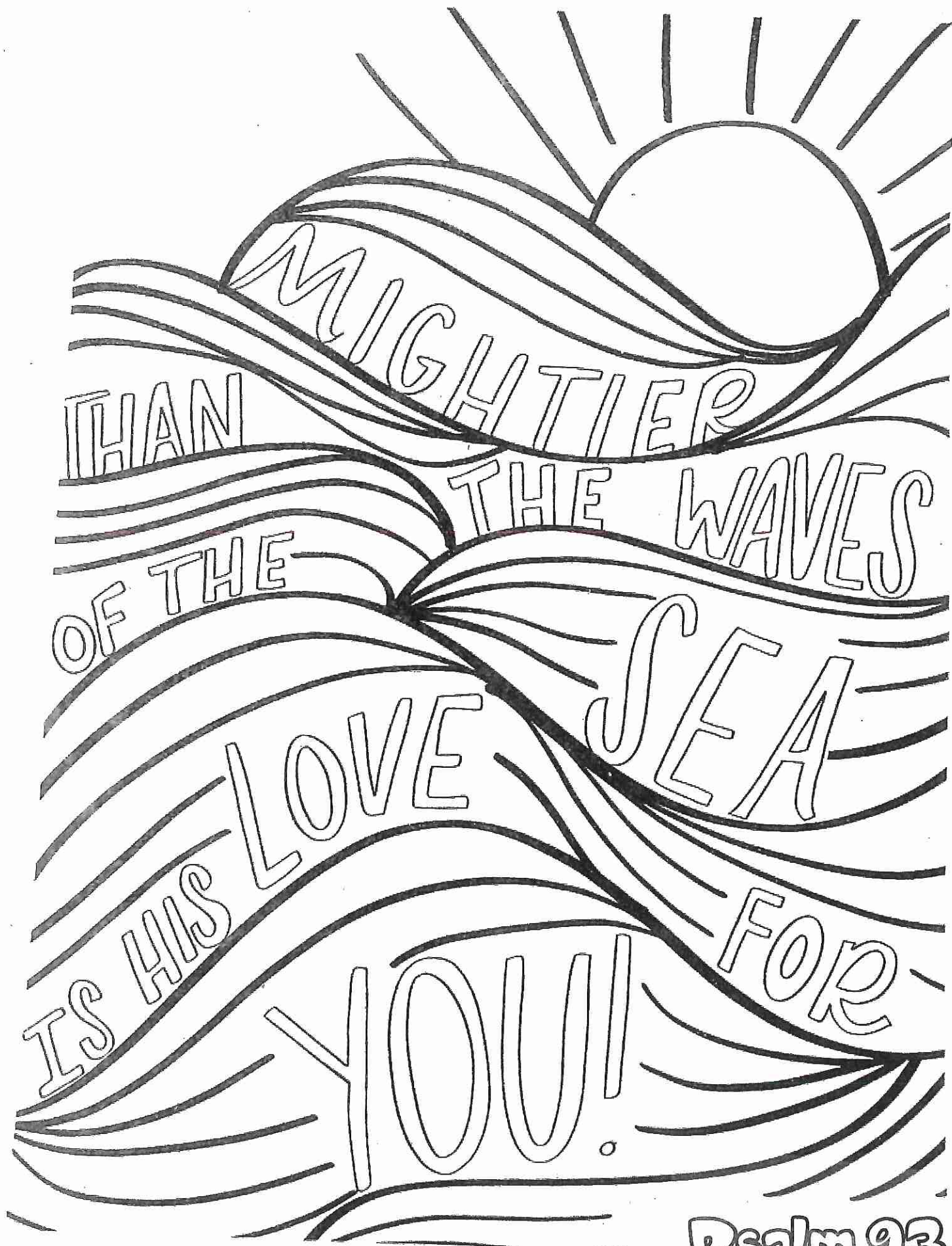


# Psalm 93 The Lord Reigns 3.14.21
