

# JOHN 21:16-19

# JESUS AND PETER

4-11-21

Use these questions as you read the Bible passage and listen to the sermon:

A quick review: Before Jesus was crucified He appeared before the high priest. Peter stood outside by a fire. When he was asked about knowing Jesus, Peter denied knowing Jesus 3 times. Then a rooster crowed.

In these verses Peter is with Jesus on the beach. Jesus has filled their nets with fish and cooked breakfast over a fire for the disciples. Now Jesus talks with Peter.

16	When they had finished breakfast, Jesus said to Simon Peter, "Simon, son of John, do you love Me more than these?" He said to him, "Yes, Lord; You know that I love You." He said to him, "Feed My lambs."	How many times did Jesus deny knowing Jesus?  In Matthew 26 Peter promised Jesus that no matter what the other disciples did, he would never fall away from loving Jesus. How does Peter respond to Jesus' question about faithfulness?
16	Jesus said to him a second time, "Simon, son of John, do you love Me?" He said to Him, "Yes, Lord; You know that I love You." He said to him, "Tend My sheep."	Why does Jesus address Peter by his first name: Simon? Is there a reason?  Do you remember what "Peter" means?
17	He said to him the third time, "Simon, son of John, do you love Me?" Peter was grieved because He said to him the third time, "Do you love Me?" and he said to Him, "Lord, You know everything; You know that I love You." Jesus said to him, "Feed My sheep."	What does the word "grieved" mean? Why did Peter say he was grieved? Do you think Peter was sorry for how he had denied knowing Jesus 3 times?  What makes Peter say that he knows Jesus knows everything?
	Why did Jesus die on the cross – what does it mean that Jesus has washed our sins away with His blood?	
	Are you completely forgiven for all of your sins or just some of your sins?	
	What is the main idea in these verses?	
	What do you do when you do not honor Jesus?

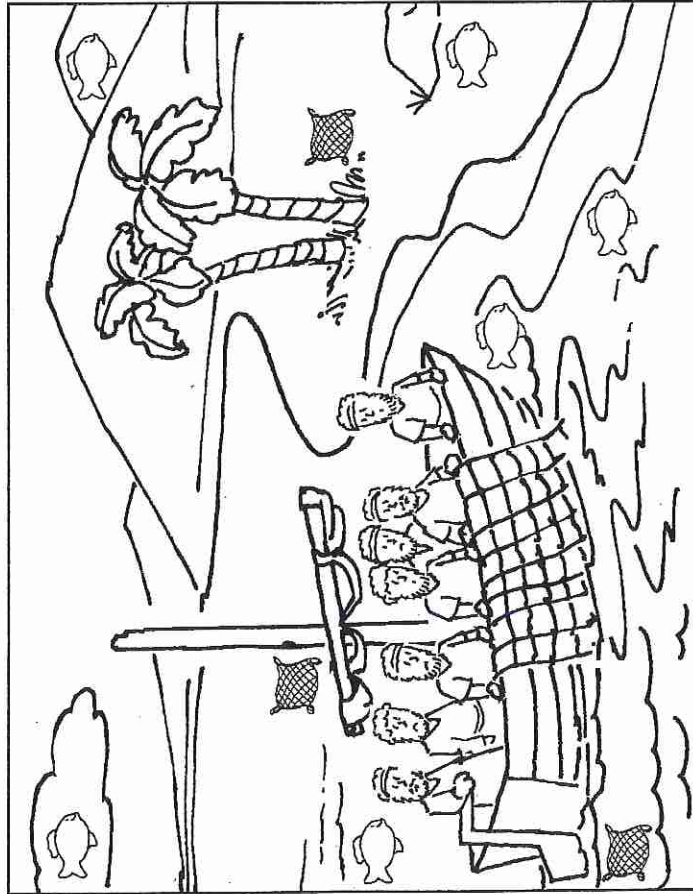

## Jesus and the Big Catch of Fish

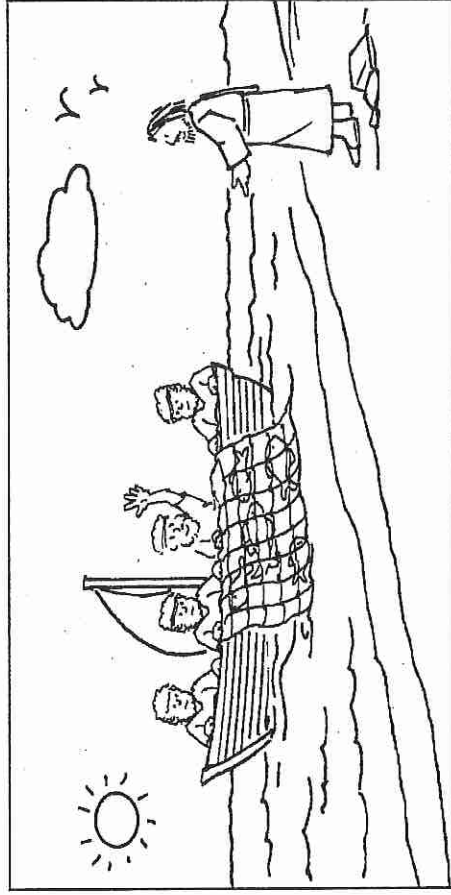
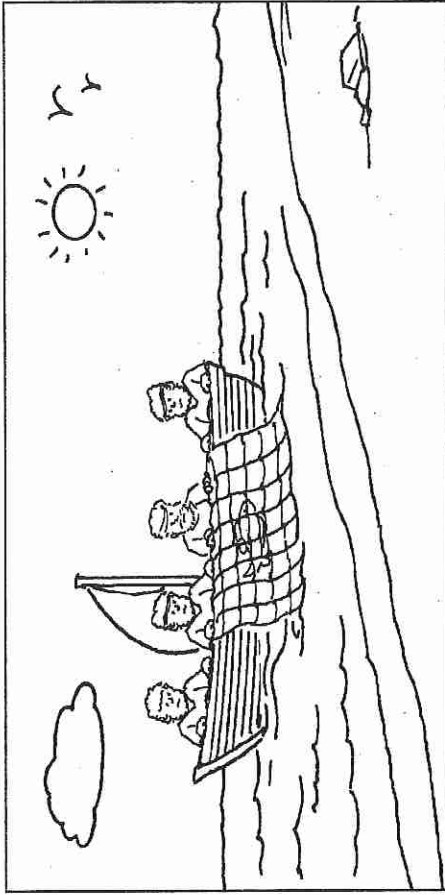
Peter and 6 other disciples went to catch fish. They did not catch any.

Circle 5 differences in the bottom picture.



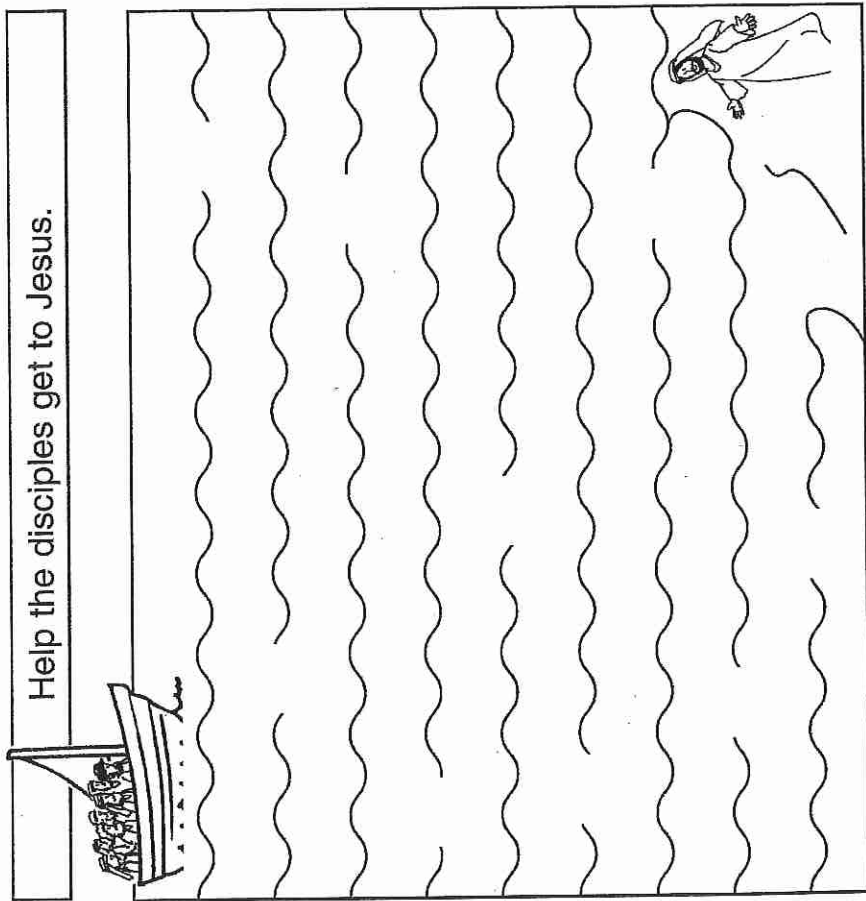
He said, "Throw your net on the right side of the boat. ..." When they did, they were unable to haul the net in because of the large number of fish.

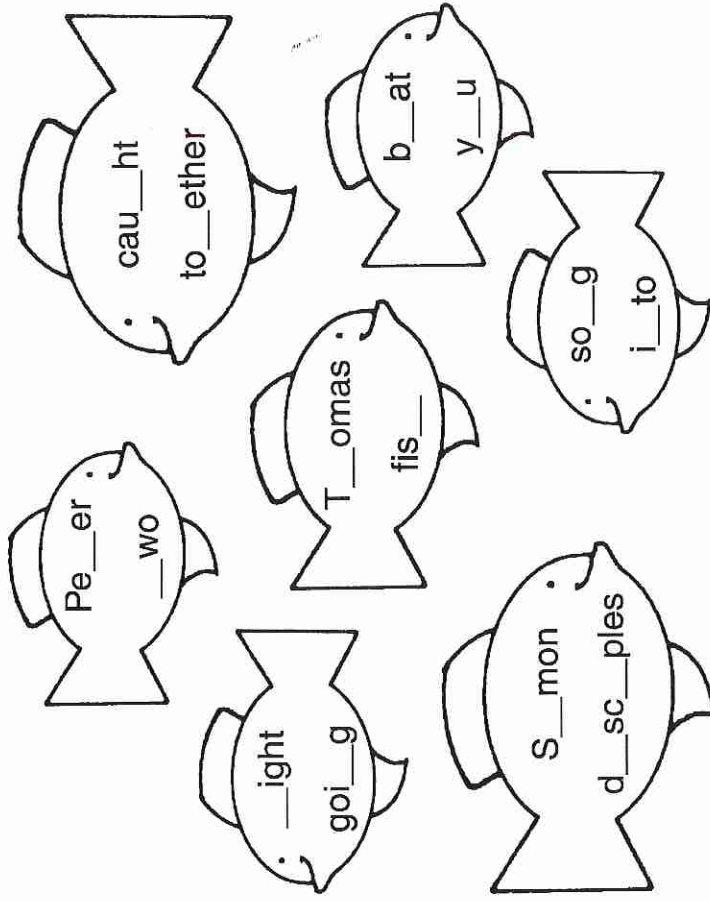

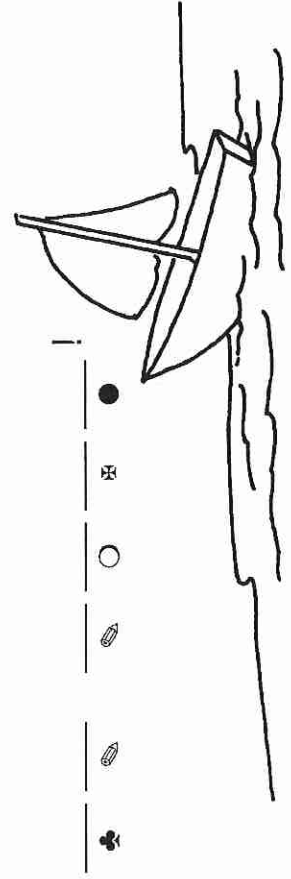
So they did as He suggested.

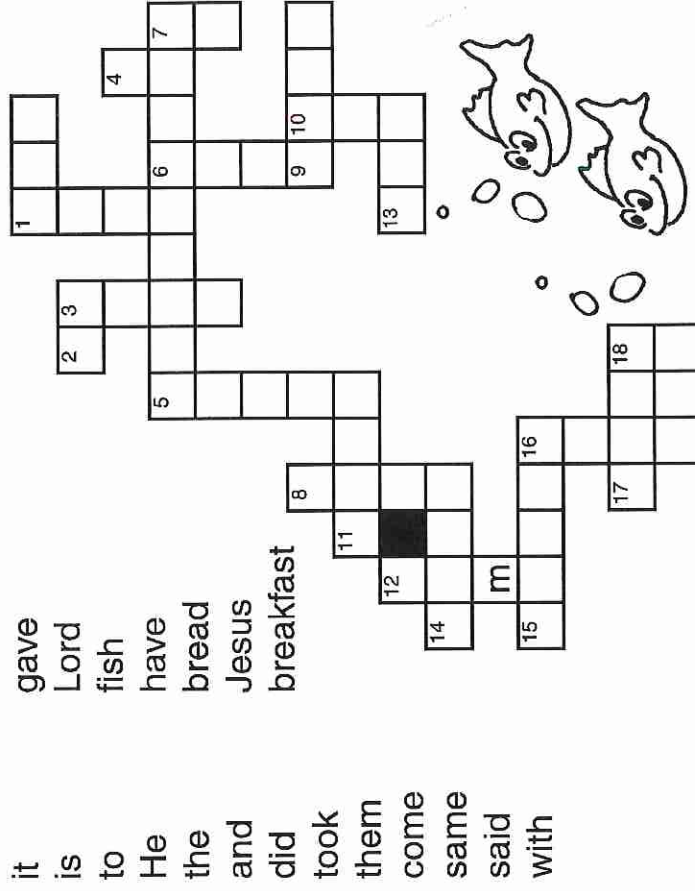
