

# JOHN 21:18-25 CALLING APRIL 18, 2021

Read and listen for the answers to this last chapter:

	Jesus meets with His disciples by the Sea of Galilee	
18	Truly, truly, I say to you, when you were young, you used to dress yourself and walk wherever you wanted, but when you are old, you will stretch out your hands, and another will dress you and carry you where you do not want to go.”	How are older people different from younger people?  What is Jesus talking about when He says “someone will stretch out their hands”?
19	(This He said to show by what kind of death he was to glorify God.) And after saying this He said to him, “Follow Me.”	Who was going to die on a cross?
20	Peter turned and saw the disciple whom Jesus loved following them, the one who also had leaned back against Him during the supper and had said, “Lord, who is it that is going to betray You?”	Who is Peter asking Jesus about?
21	When Peter saw him, he said to Jesus, “Lord, what about this man (John)?”	What does Peter’s question mean?
22	Jesus said to him, “If it is My will that he (John) remain until I come, what is that to you (Peter)? <b><i>You follow Me!</i></b> ”	Jesus told His disciples many times “FOLLOW ME.”  Where do you learn how to follow Jesus?
23	So the saying spread abroad among the brothers that this disciple was not to die; yet Jesus did not say to him that he was not to die, but, “If it is My will that he remain until I come, what is that to you?”	When do you follow Jesus?  Is following Jesus always easy?
24	This is the disciple who is bearing witness about these things, and who has written these things, and we know that his testimony is true.	Where do you get the strength to keep following Jesus?
25	Now there are also many other things that Jesus did. Were every one of them to be written, I suppose that the world itself could not contain the books that would be written.

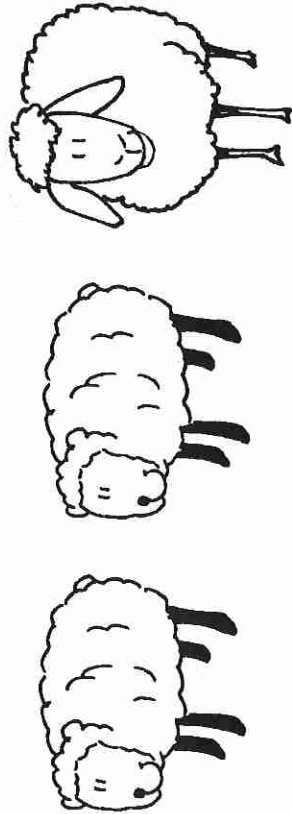
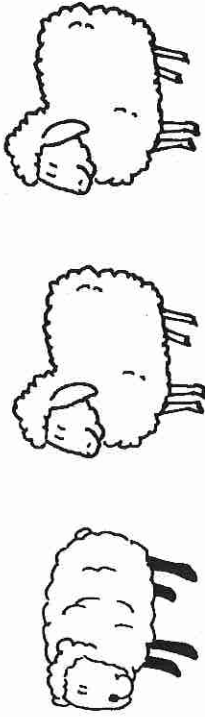
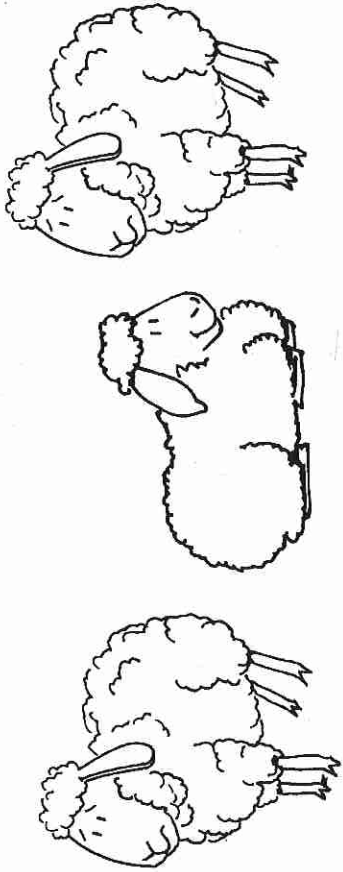

In the story, find 14 words that don't make sense or seem out of place. Replace them with words from the list that have only 1 letter different.

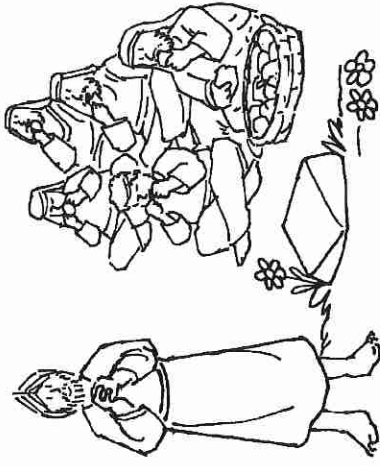
