


Psalm 23 The Lord Is My Shepherd

1	The LORD is my Shepherd; I shall not want.	Why doesn't the writer need anything?
2	He makes me lie down in green pastures. He leads me beside still waters.	What did God provide for him?
3	He restores my soul. He leads me in paths of righteousness for His name's sake.	What is a path of righteousness? Who leads the shepherd? Why does He lead the shepherd?
4	Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for You are with me; Your rod and Your staff, they comfort me.	How do you know the shepherd knew about death? Why wasn't he afraid? How can a rod and staff bring comfort?
5	You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies; You anoint my head with oil; my cup overflows.	How do you know the shepherd faced hard time? How does the Good Shepherd help in times of trouble?
6	Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life, and I shall dwell in the house of the LORD forever.	Who does goodness and mercy belong to? How does the shepherd get this goodness and mercy? What is the end result of the work of the Good Shepherd?
