**Call to Confession**

Matthew 22:37-40

## Public Confession

Minister: Let us confess our sins together.

**All: Most holy and merciful Father, please forgive us for our many trespasses and sins; for we have often sinned in thought, word, and deed; by what we have done, and by what we have left undone. We have not loved you with our whole heart, and mind, and strength. We have not loved our neighbors as ourselves. We have often thought more of ourselves than we have of our neighbors, and we have often compared ourselves to each other instead of loving each other. We have held grudges and refused to forgive others, as we have been forgiven. We have been deaf to your call to serve others, as Christ served us. We confess to you, Lord, all our past unfaithfulness, pride, hypocrisy, and impatience. We confess our self-indulgent appetites and ways, our exploitation of other people, our anger at our own frustration, our envy of those more fortunate than ourselves, our intemperate love of worldly goods and comforts, our dishonesty in daily life and work, and our negligence in prayer and worship. Restore us, good Lord. Accomplish in us the work of your salvation, that we may show forth your glory in the world. Amen.**
