Matthew 22:37-40

Public Confession

Minister: Let us confess our sins together.

We confess our self-indulgent appetites and ways, our exploitation of other people, our anger at our own frustration, our envy of those more fortunate than ourselves, our intemperate love of worldly goods and comforts, our dishonesty in daily life and work, and our negligence in prayer and worship. Restore us, good Lord. Accomplish in us the work of your salvation, that we may show forth your glory in the world. Amen.
