



This week we will be using the *Five Solas of the Reformation* to guide our time of family worship. The Latin word, “*sola*”, meaning “alone”, is used to emphasize the Reformation’s teaching that salvation is revealed in Scripture alone (*sola scriptura*), and is attained through grace alone (*sola gratia*), by faith alone (*sola fide*), in Christ alone (*solus Christus*), for the glory of God alone (*solus Deo Gloria*).

**Answer:** The Word of God, which is contained in the Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments, is the only rule to direct us how we may glorify and enjoy him.

**Question:** What do the Scriptures principally teach?

**Answer:** The Scriptures principally teach what man is to believe concerning God, and what duty God requires of man.

**Answer:** Justification is an act of God's free grace, wherein he pardons all our sins, and accepts us as righteous in His sight, only for the righteousness of Christ imputed to us, and received by faith alone.

*Romans 3:21-31*

- What does this text teach us about nature of justification? Can we earn it?
- How does this text teach that justification is by faith *alone*?

*The Westminster Shorter Catechism Q/A 20*

**Question:** Did God leave all mankind to perish in the estate of sin and misery?

**Answer:** God, having out of his mere good pleasure, from all eternity, elected some to everlasting life, did enter into a covenant of grace to deliver them, out of the estate of sin and misery, and to bring them into an estate of salvation by a Redeemer.

- What does this text teach us about the role of grace in our salvation?
- How does this text teach us that salvation is by grace *alone*?

- How does this text teach that we are to live for the glory of God *alone*?
